The English club was inaugurated by Dr.R.Kasthuri Bai, HOD of English, Sri Sarada College for Women, on 21.11.09.



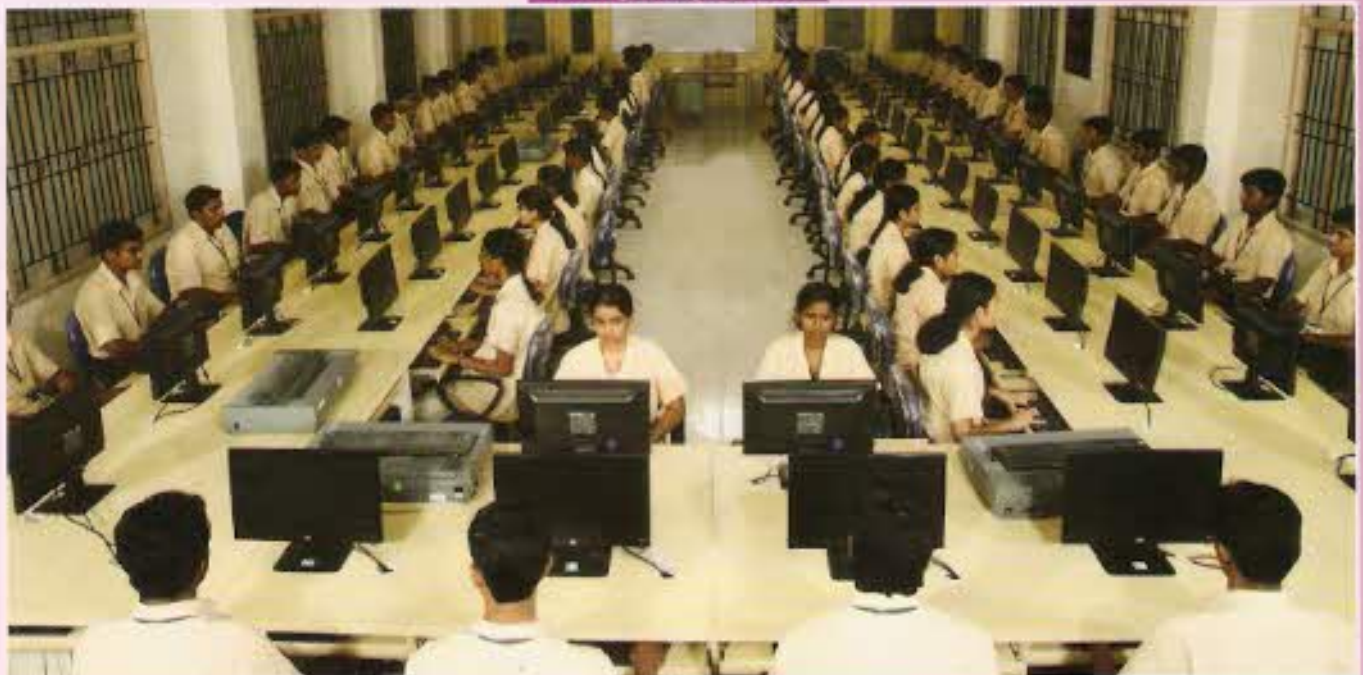
